Ref: The last week of school Monday 19th – Friday 23rd July

I am writing to inform you of the arrangements for the last week of school w/c Monday 19th July. As you will hopefully have seen from Mr. Perry's video, the school will be looking to operate a different learning pattern during the last week to accommodate the festival of Eid.

As such the last full day of in-school learning will take place on Monday 19th July, this is also the date on which your child will bring home their end of year report.

For **Tuesday 20th – Friday 23rd July** the school will switch to remote learning for all pupils throughout the school. Work will be set on the remote learning platforms for pupils and this will include video lessons and modelling with pupils expected to upload their work/photos of their work each day. Please work with us to support your children in the completion of the given tasks each day. If you have any concerns about this then your first point of contact will be your child's class teacher.

The school will offer limited places in school on Tuesday 20th – Friday 23rd July for those children whose parents are considered essential key workers as per the Essential Worker List published by the government during the January to March lockdown, and are in need of a place. If you believe that this includes your role, please contact the school office to speak to a member of staff.

On Thursday 22nd and Friday 23rd July we will be looking to invite parents to school to have end of year meetings to discuss pupil progress and areas of development for over the summer. We know that you will agree that whilst the children need a good rest after a hectic year, it is in their interests to continue to practice and maintain key skills such as reading, writing and maths – if they are to make more rapid and sustained progress upon their return in September.
